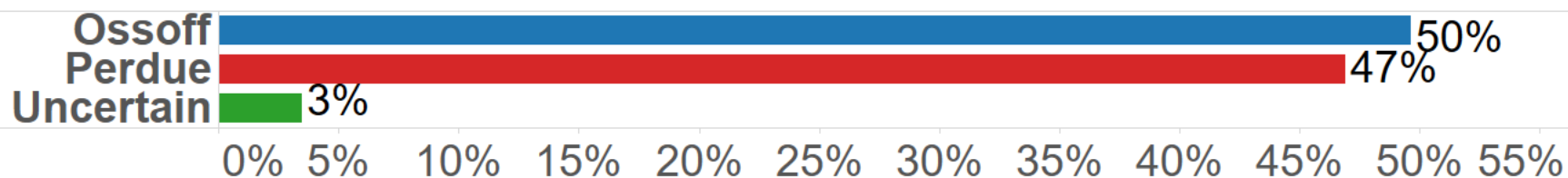

## Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 1,011 registered, likely voters in Georgia. The poll was conducted from December 29<sup>th</sup> through the 30<sup>th</sup> and has a margin of error of 3.1%. The survey was collected from respondents using interactive voice responses and an online panel of cell phone users. The results are weighted by relevant voting demographics. The poll was paid for by Gravis Marketing Institute.

1) If the election for Senate were held today, for whom would you vote?

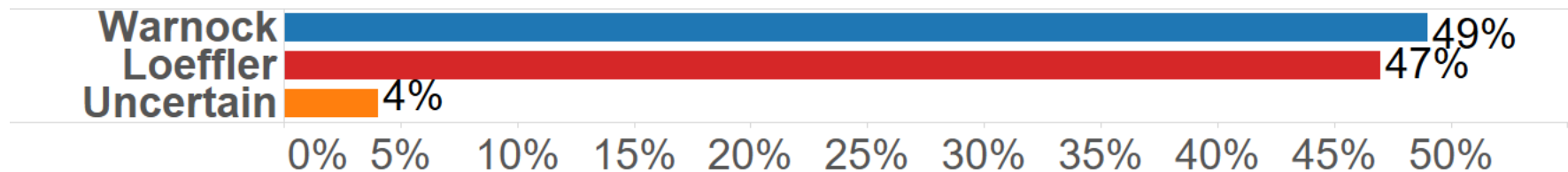

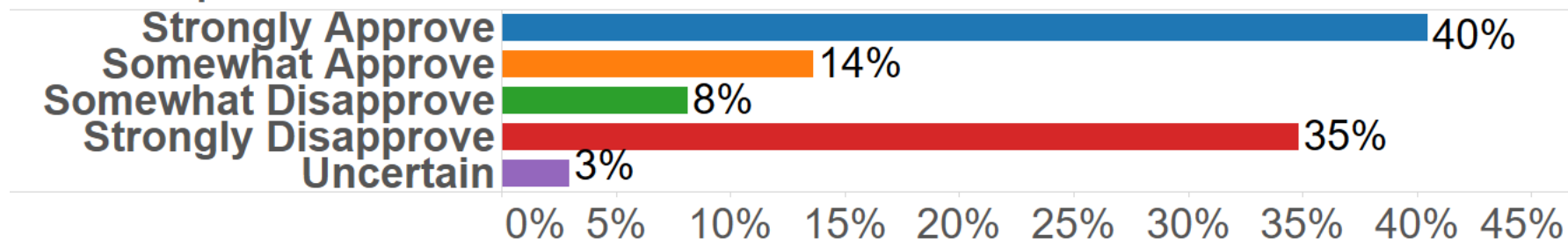

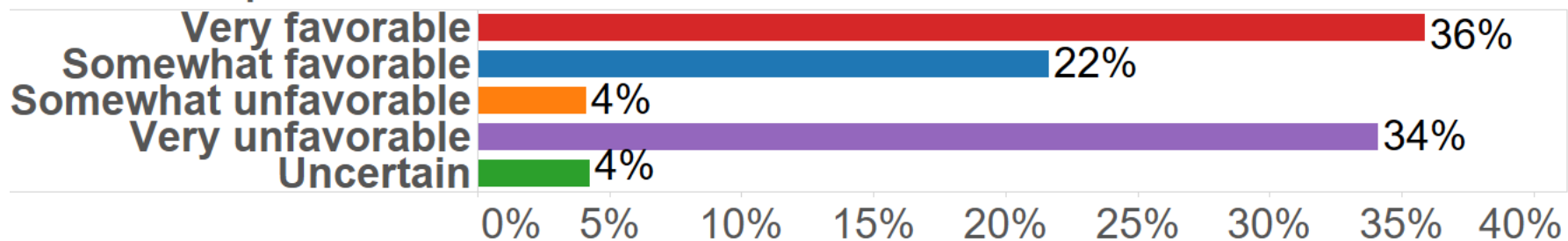

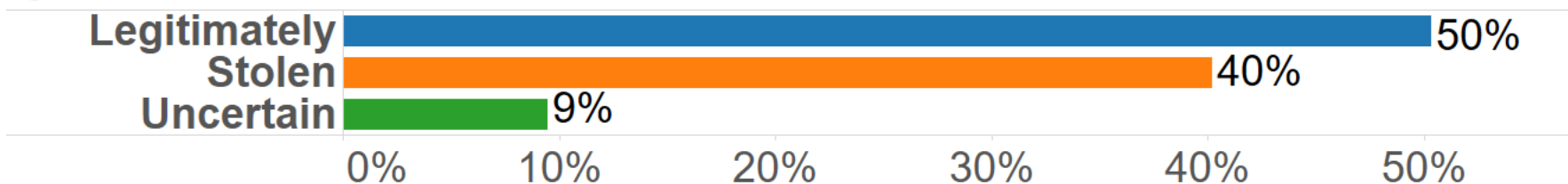

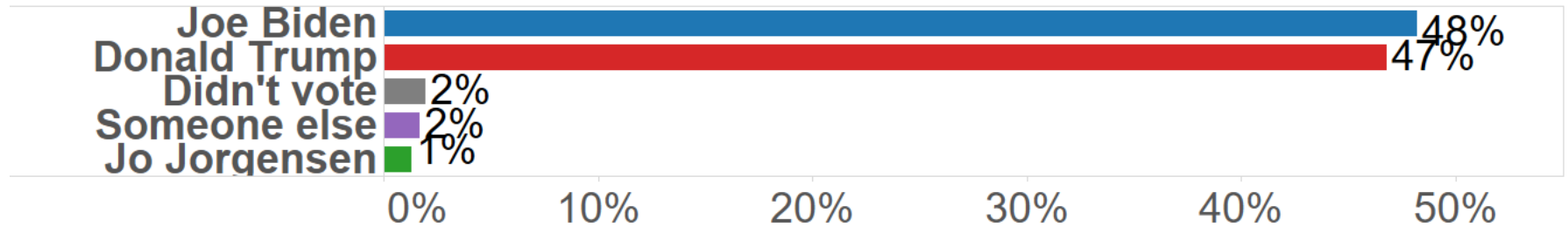

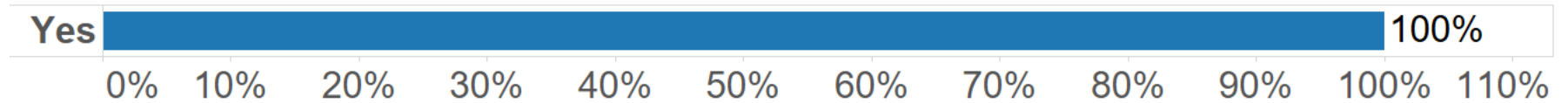

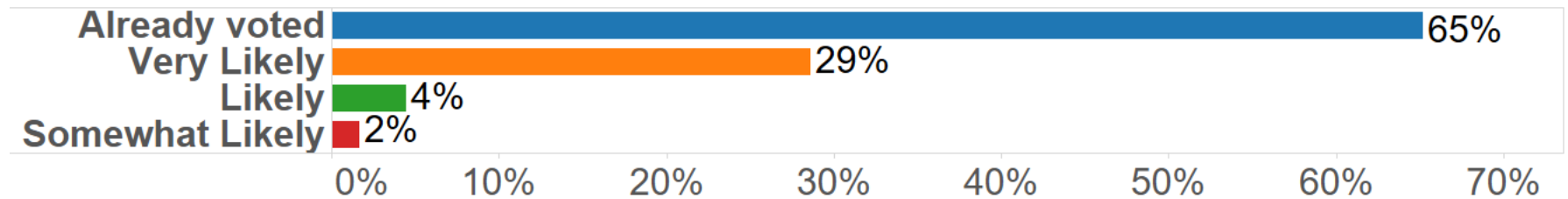

**Registered**



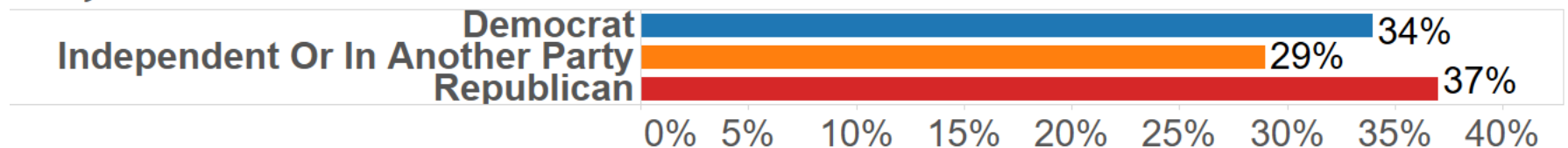
8) How likely are you to vote in the runoff election this January?

**Likelihood**



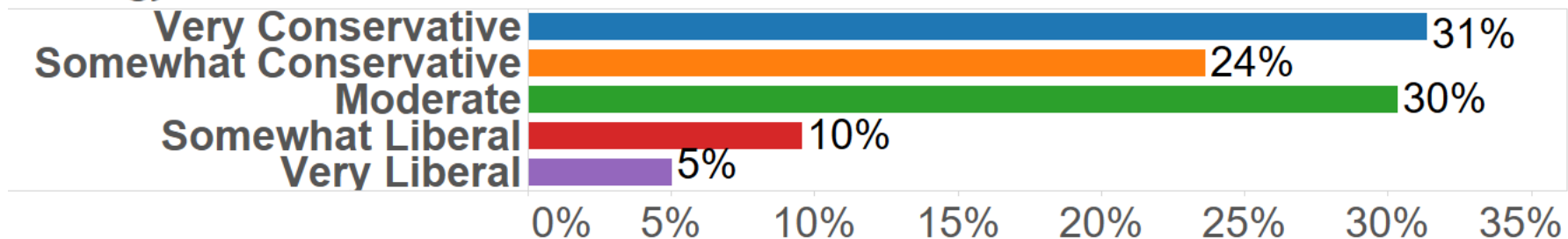
9) What is your party affiliation?

**Party**



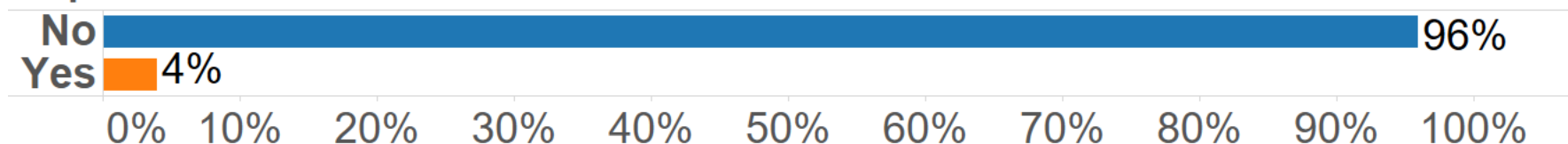
10) What is your political ideology?

### Ideology



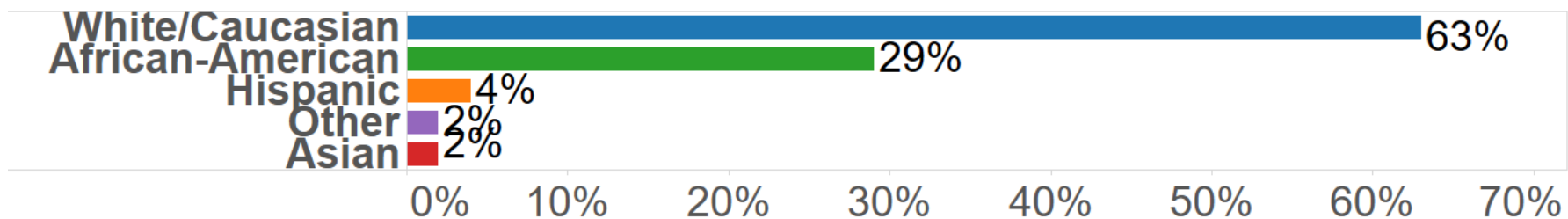
11) Are you or is a member of your immediate family from a Latino, Hispanic or Spanish speaking background?

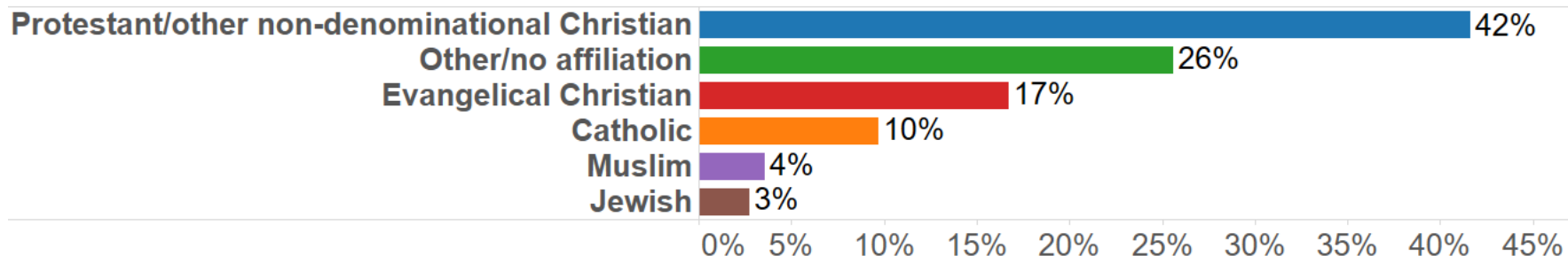

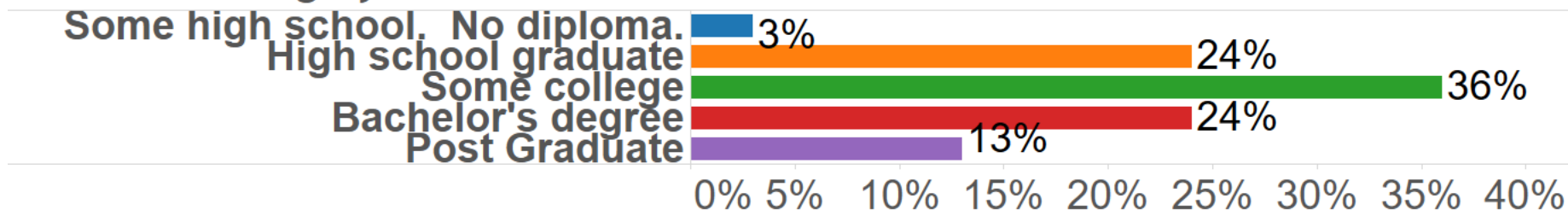
13) Which of the following best represents your religious affiliation?

### Religious affiliation



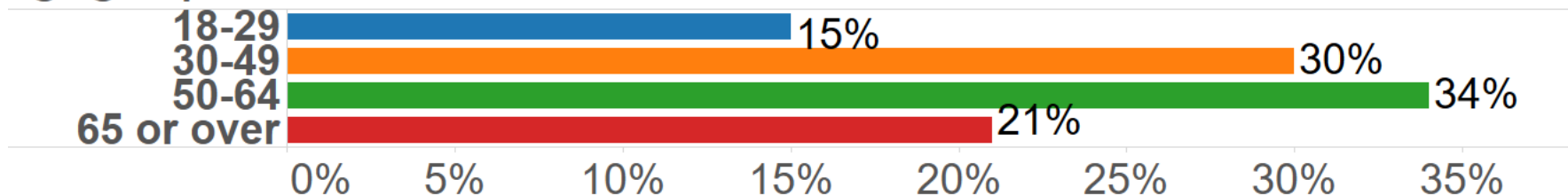
14) What is the highest level of education you have completed?
